STORAGE: Store at room temperature. Long-term, EPIMARK™ Markers should be kept in their polybags to prevent moisture loss. Some colors may change slightly after long storage—rotate stock.

If a change occurs in the material, process, or marking technique, always retest. Due to varying conditions within the industry, Epic cannot assume responsibility for use of its markers. With yarns that are substantially coated (e.g., tire cord or fiber glass for circuit boards), EPIMARK may leave residual traces that could interfere with adhesion. Marks may not be fully soluble in hot water, use mild alkali or detergent.
