05 BA5 SPINDLE TAPE INSTALLATION AND ADJUSTMENT

I. Spindle Drive Tape Installation:

- 1. Remove the lower spindle rail cover.
- 2. Lift swing with tension pulley up and pull off spindle drive tape.

Note: On direct cabling machine:

- A. Loosen J-tube and slide to side
- B. Pull the spindle drive from drive shaft pulley and guide pulley passing between brake lining bracket and spindle whorl. This can be done by loosening spindle housing.
- C. Mount new drive tape in similar manner.

Warning: Drive surface must have contact with spindle whorl, shaft pulley, tension and guide pulley. **Lettered, shiny** surface of tape should be outside.

- 3. Pass drive tape around shaft pulley and guide pulley.
- 4. Pull swing up and pass tape around tension pulley.

II. Spindle Drive Tape Adjustment:

- 1. Loosen tension pulley; turn set screw (1) 10mm out.
- 2. Pull swing up, place 6mm thick spacer gauge between spindle rail and swing.
- 3. Turn set screw (1) in until 6mm spacer is released.
- 4. Fasten pulley, secure set screw with lock nut.
- 5. Loosen lock nut for set screw (2) of swing motion.
- 6. Turn screw by hand until resistance is felt. Turn screw back two threads; secure with lock nut.

III. To Check the Adjustment:

- 1. Turn main switch to position one, but do not start machine.
- 2. Press brake pedal into locked position
- 3. Slide 4mm hex key between pulley and drive tape (wrench must slide with some resistance).

Note: When spindle is disengaged while machine is in operation, the drive tape floats over the main drive pulley. Tension and guide pulley should not turn.
